Principal’s Message



There will not be any new school work going home with students for the 2019-2020 school year. K-5 packet materials need to be turned in on Monday, May 18th. Students have until Thursday, May 28th to turn in any other work during normal office hours of 10:00 a.m.-2:00 p.m.

Grades 6-8 will return Chromebooks, chargers, library books, and classroom books if they are FINISHED with everything. Staff will be here from 8:00-4:00 pm. Below is other important information for the end of the year.

- Monday, May 18th - Grades 6-8 will return the above items at the North gym door in the parking lot.
- Monday, May 18th - Mr. Flores will be here so that students can clean their PE lockers out. Students will be able to go in the locker room, two at a time. If students need to get materials from their hallway locker, they will give the locker number to a staff member and that person will go get their stuff. Students will not be allowed in the hallways.
- Thursday, May 21st - Students that have music instruments need to have them turned in.
- Wednesday, May 27th - K-7th grade parade. Staff will line up on 4th Street. Students will drive up 4th Street and staff will greet them with signs and wave to them. The parade will go from 10:30-11:30 am.
- Thursday, May 28th - 8th grade continuation parade at 5:00 pm.
- Thursday, May 28th - Last day for students to turn work in.
- Friday, May 29th will be the last day for staff and grades will be finalized.
